



SAFE ROUTES PLAN

SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Advantage Arts Academy (AAA) is located at 6171 W. 11800 S. in Herriman. Students are highly encouraged to arrive and depart in carpools or guardian vehicles. Parents and students should follow the school's designated car loop procedures to ensure students' safety and the efficiency of traffic flow through the area.

The school is located on a developing frontage road and students should not be dropped off or picked up on 11800 S. The roadway in the immediate area around the school is not recommended for pedestrian or bicycle transportation, as it is a designated truck route.

Parents who choose to allow their students to walk or bike to and from Advantage Arts Academy will assume responsibility for all risks involved. Travelers should obey all traffic lights, laws, signs, and signals and cross carefully and legally to enter school grounds.

ROUTES

North and East

Advantage Arts Academy advises against students walking or biking to and from school along 11800 S., especially during heavy traffic time periods on the roadway as the area is missing adequate sidewalks, crosswalks, and bike lanes for students to safely travel upon. Parents and students who decide to walk or bike to and from school should follow the safest route possible using sidewalks, crosswalks, and pedestrian trails where available.

Note that the posted speed limit along 11800 S. is 35 mph and the area near Herriman High is a designated School Zone. There is a crosswalk located at 11800 S. and 6000 W. that does not connect to AAA, but may in the future.

South and West

The school is accessible to individuals residing in the Richmond American Homes Jackson subdivision west of the school. Students are advised to travel from their home to east toward

the school following the applicable path of Teton Park Drive to Antelope Flat Way or Signal Crest Drive then entering the southwest corner of the school grounds.

This plan covers only the immediate area around Advantage Arts Academy and is not exhaustive.

AREA IMPROVEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

To increase student safety, as well as walking and biking access to the school facilities for students residing in the neighboring residential areas, the following items are considerations the school would propose as area improvements.

Provide a crossing guard at the intersection of 11800 S. and 6000 W.

- during student travel times (thirty minutes before and after school).
- Installation of sidewalks along 11800 S. connecting the school grounds to the intersection of 11800 S. and 6000 W.
- Red curbing on 11800 S. directly in front of the school accompanied by no parking signs.

Please note, the school does not oversee area improvements and only local government agencies can determine which recommendations to undergo.
