The following are the plans for instruction according to the three different possible learning models that may occur throughout the school year based on the most current information provided by the Governor’s office and the Health Department. Advantage Arts will begin the year with Daily In Person Model or Face to Face Learning.

<p>Teachers will be on campus during their contracted hours Monday through Friday.</p> <p>All students will attend school five days a week for the entire school day.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All safety protocols and procedures will be followed. See Safety Plan for all safety protocols and procedures. • Teachers will be using school adopted curriculum and art integration to provide in school instruction. • Grades will be taken and entered weekly. • Attendance will be taken daily. • All benchmark assessments will be given. 	<p>Teachers will be on campus during their contracted hours Monday through Friday.</p> <p>Students will be divided in half to reduce the number of students in the classroom. Students will be divided by their last name as much as possible to ensure a balance of students in each class. Students will attend school for face to face instruction two days each week and virtual learning the other three days.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be identified as on Schedule A or Schedule B. • Schedule A will come to school on Monday and Wednesdays and Schedule B will come to school on Tuesdays and Thursdays. • All students will stay home on Fridays and complete assignments or receive small group instruction from their teacher. • Teachers will be available on Fridays to assist students through Zoom or answer parents’ questions. • Holiday weeks will have an adjusted schedule that will be communicated to families. 	<p>Teachers will be instructing from their remote locations Monday through Friday.</p> <p>All students will be participating in distance learning, attending daily virtual lesson with their teacher through Zoom, and completing assignments through Google Classroom.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be taught how to access and utilize the Google Classroom platform. • Parents will be provided with information about how to access and utilize the Google Classroom platform. • Teachers will provide a virtual live session with students daily on Zoom to provide direct instruction in curriculum areas. • Teachers will utilize the online component of the math and ELA curriculum to provide students with assignments and leveled reading books. • Grades will be taken and entered weekly. • Weekly attendance protocols will be followed. • Special education services and support to continue during Distance At Home Learning.

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- Parents will be provided with information about how to access and utilize the Google Classroom platform.
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- Attendance will be taken daily.
- All benchmark assessments will be given.
- Kindergarten will still attend on their assigned days for their normal school hours.

- Benchmark assessments will be given virtually if possible.
